We invest in children!

- They are loved unconditionally, no matter what people say.
- They were born with a godly identity.
- They have a purpose and calling in their lives.
- They belong to a family.

They will start living from a Godly worldview with Word-based morals and choices.

WHY US?

We have been doing the **Kids In Ministry** process since 2012. We have seen children be transformed from shy children that react as a result of the pain they have, to children who lead with passion and live with purpose.

WE CREATE A SAFE ENVIRONMENT FOR CHILDREN TO:

- **Discover** their godly **identity and intimacy** with their heavenly Father.
- **Find healing and restoration** in a world where parents are absent and hurt.
- **Be equipped to stand on God's Word** in modern society.
- **Be empowered to BE the change** where they are.

ACTIVITIES

Our process is divided into two camps per year and the desire is that children do at least four camps to be fully equipped.

KIM CAMP CONSISTING OF:

- Themed camp, including gift packs and projects to complete.
- The content is focused on establishing identity and purpose.
- We focus on building relationships with children to create a breeding ground for growth and impartation.

KIM LEAD CAMP CONSISTING OF:

- Survivor themed camp, including gift packs and projects to complete.

- The content is focused on leadership development and building a stronger Word base.
- We focus on building in-depth relationships.
- They are given an outreach project that they need to complete and give feedback on.

TRAINING ADULT LEADERS:

- To be facilitators and small group leaders.
- Local leadership involvement:
- Having a variety of churches involved in the camps.

COVID ALIGNMENT HYBRID CAMP:

- The hybrid camp will use different social media platforms to interact with children
- The Focus will still be on small groups.
- Teaching will be done via video
- Goody bags will be provided at a drive-through registration at various locations.
- Facilitators training all as mentioned above.
- The camp will end off with a drive-in service

EXPECTED OUTPUTS

Two KIM camps per year.

PREPARATION:

- Sourcing and booking campgrounds
- Sourcing acquiring camp resources
- Preparing materials and resource packs for each child and volunteer.

SERVING:

- Volunteers as facilitators and small group leaders.
- Community leadership involvement.
- Sponsorships for struggling families, to give all children a fair opportunity.

EQUIPPING LEADERS:

Leadership training:

- All leaders will go through a rigorous vetting process.
- Walking with wounded children.
- Facilitation of the program.

Buy-in from various congregations:

- Local churches taking up responsibility for the next generation having continuous investments and follow-up process.

EXPECTED OUTCOMES

We trust that children will understand:

- That they are loved unconditionally by their heavenly Father.

- That they need to forgive and love themselves and others as Christ did.
- That God planned them and has a purpose and calling for them.
- Their relationship with God, standing firm on His Word is the premise from which they lead.
- Being God's representatives by living a life that will draw others to Christ.

They will step up to lead in their environment and be the voice of reason in times of chaos.

EXPECTED IMPACT

Having Children impacting their families, schools and communities by:

- Living with purpose and passion.
- Understanding their identity in Christ.
- Living from a Word-based worldview and not from a place of entitlement.
- Stepping up to lead when the norm is to be passive.
- Showing love to all without prejudice or exception.
- Living in Godly authority and compassion in ungodly circumstances.
- Continuously finding comfort and healing in intimacy with God.

BUDGET REQUIRED

SPONSOR A CHILD FOR A CAMP	R2 100.00
Gift Pack & Activities	R350.00
Travelling costs	R250.00
Accommodation	R850.00
Food for 5-day camp	R650.00

We only charge the kids R1850p.p. to make it affordable. Thus we have a shortfall of R 250 per child.

SPONSOR A LEADER	R2 850.00
Leaders camping costs	R2 100.00
Data Packages	R100.00
Team-wear	R650.00

We only charge the leaders their team-wear costs.
Thus our shortfall per leader is R2200.00
